Safe Child Thailand has been supporting vulnerable children and families in Thailand for over 40 years. In the past year alone, we have directly supported more than 9,000 children and their families six provinces across Thailand.

Nong Khai, we provided essential support, and child protection training on the Thailand-Myanmar border. In Bangkok Lat Krabang, we assisted families with children with disabilites through therapy and training. In Mae Sot, we improved educational opportunities with scholarships, vocational training, and English classes. Nationally, we advocated for alternative childcare, supporting the transition of an orphanage to a family support centre in Chiang Mai.

£17 a month can keep a family together through income support


£50 will support a child and a teacher with mental health training, emotional wellbeing support, and coaching from a professional
